Who is Playing – Everyone will be required to perform at this event. Everyone will be part of a Full Woodwind Choir or Full Brass Choir from each band. If you are signed up for Honor Credit, you need to perform a solo or an ensemble. If you would like to perform a solo, there will be cash prizes given away for the following:

- 1st \$150 Gift Card Top Performer from Wind Ensemble
- 2nd \$100 Gift Card Top Performer/Performers from Wind Ensemble

- 3rd \$50 Gift Card Top Performer/Performers from Wind Ensemble
- 1st \$150 Gift Card Top Performer/Performers from Symphonic Band
- 2nd \$100 Gift Card Top Performer/Performers from Symphonic Band
- 3rd \$50 Gift Card Top Performer/Performers from Symphonic Band

Cost – This year, the school will take care of the cost of the judges.

What to Play – It is encouraged that music should be off the UIL PML list. If you cannot find something off the UIL PML list to fit your needs, then your choice needs to be approved through the directors. All music needs to be signed off by your director from your band. Your Solo Does NOT have to be memorized. We have music in the library that you may search through and use. If you choose to do a solo, then you are also responsible for the price of an accompanist. Here is the list of accompanists. You may also choose someone that you know.

What is the Format – It will be a concert where everyone will play in public in the Auditorium. Audience will be limited and spread out with CDC protocols instilled. Full Choirs will be center of the stage with solo's and ensembles being set up on stage left or stage right. The solo's will be judged by an outside panel of judges who will select the top 3 performers from each band. The top 3 performers from each band will win cash prizes listed above.

- Winter Guard Fees We have set up the link for you to start paying Winter Guard Fees. Here is the information for paying fees:
 - On the band website (https://www.amcbands.com/), parents can go to the Winter Guard box under the weekly schedule or can select "Winter Guard Fees 2021" under the Parents/Students tab at the top of the website. They can also use this direct link if that is easier https://www.amcbands.com/shop-1.
 - Once on this page, there are four boxes at the bottom and parents can pay for January, February, March, and April fees. Each installment is \$45.00. If parents are going to pay each month, this is how they would pay. If a parent wants to pay the full \$180 now, they can select the January box and change the quantity from I to 4 and then proceed to checkout to make the payment. It is set up that parents must put in an email address (which is where a receipt is sent), name, address, and student name. These are required fields so I can match up the payment with students to know who has or has not paid.

• **School Instrument Fee** – The school owned instrument fee will be collected through the school system. Your Student has been given an invoice from the school for you to pay the school.
